# ND HS Graduation Requirements

---

## State requires 22 credits to graduate

- 4 - **English Language Arts**
- 3 - **Mathematics**
- 3 - **Science** (Physical. Science/Biology)
- 3 - **Social Studies** (US History & Gov't, Econ or Problems/Democracy)
- 1 - **Physical Education**
- 3 - **Foreign or NA Languages, Fine Arts, OR CTE**
- 5 additional units of credit – **ELECTIVES**

---

## Other curriculum to foster student success beyond HS:

- **21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills – 4 C's**  
Critical Thinking and Problem Solving

Collaboration, Teamwork, and Leadership

# Missouri River Education Cooperative

## Project examples:


- Provides career advising assistance to school districts; offer job shadowing and internship programs
- Hosts seventh through ninth grade Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) program
- Provides math remediation and advancement programs

## Project examples:


- Supports career advisors to assist student in college and career planning

## Project examples:


- Shared career advisors, energy impact technology modules, and enhanced connections among postsecondary institutions, businesses, and students

## Project examples:


- Participate in development of Cass County Virtual CTE Center

## Project examples:


- Hosts a Career Fair with business partners

## Project examples:


- PD on 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills for a large district

## Project examples:


- Middle and High School Career Fairs







Successful completion of four-year course plans


Learning skills for postsecondary and career success
